CHAP. 53.

An Act to revive and amend the Act incorporating the Anglo-Canadian Bank.

[Assented to 23rd June, 1887.]

WHEREAS certain provisional directors of the Anglo-Preamble.
Canadian Bank, and others interested in the said bank, have, by their petition, prayed for an Act to revive and amend, as hereinafter mentioned, the Act incorporating the said bank, passed in the session held in the forty-ninth year of Her Majesty's reign, and chaptered sixty-four; and 49 V., c. 64. Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

The time specified in section five of the said Act of Time for obincorporation of the said bank, in which to obtain from the
Treasury Board the certificate required by section six of Treasury
"The Bank Act," is hereby extended to one year from the
Passing of this Act; and the charter of the said bank shall
not be deemed to have become forfeited by reason of the
said certificate not having been obtained within the time
fixed in the said section five, and the said Act to incorporate
the said bank shall be deemed to have continued and to be
in full force and effect.
