Grass By the Yard.

Many people, suburban dwellers and others, have trouble in growing satisfactory grass. There is a new way to do it.
Sow grass seed thickly on canvas, with enough loam for it to sprout in. If properly watered, the canvas will soon be covered with a fine crop of grass.
It is then ready for the lawn. The soil of the latter having been duly prepared and made smooth, cover it with the canvas grassmats, keeping them closely together. The roots of the grass plants will quickly push through the interstices of the canvas.
By this means a lawn can be made in a few hours.

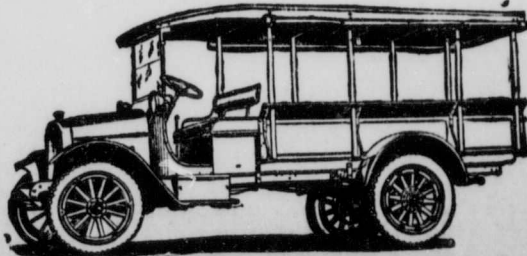
