One of our exchanges from the West enlightens its readers by informing that Dr. Joseph Worcester, author of a large standard dictionary and inventor of Worcester's sauce, is a similar case.

It is stated that Dickens obtained the idea for his new novel of Oliver Twist from a bundle of drawings by Crankshaw, intended to illustrate, without letter press, the life of a London thief, and that the characters of Nancy, Fagin, Sykes, the Dodger, and Charley Bates, were suggested by the sketches of the artist.

A London paper furnishes a curious picture of the doings at an English election. Some fifty years ago, a candidate in a public hall sent to one of the candidates for bread, cheese and vinegar furnished for the purpose of solving one of the election, who, having promised to vote for the opposite candidate, was found drunk in a cowshed, and having been sobered by the means above mentioned, was induced to vote on the same side as the donor of the bread, cheese, and vinegar.

New Colonization Scheme.—Lately we have been visited by some intelligent and wealthy Germans, who have been some time in the United States, but desire a country and laws more congenial to them and where they may be able to live as under the Stars and Stripes. From what could be learned from them, they desire to commence a settlement in Canada, and to settle entirely with Germans. They propose bringing about fifty well-to-do farmers, who could bring means of support for at least a year, and where they begin. They also think that nothing less than three townships would be required for the colony.

A young lady of Williamsburg, N. Y., who was a prison last winter as the handsomely lovely present at a certain entertainment, or fair, was married the other day. The rush of people to see the interesting conveyance performed was very great, and two or three hours before the appointed time the street was completely blocked up. Upon opening the church, the crowd rushed in, climbing over the tops of the pews and in at the windows, to the great injury of the cushions and byrnes and the happy couple, but most of the invited guests were crowded out.

It is estimated, says the Trade Review, that about five hundred families have left Quebec with the Government. If we family spent \$1000 a year, and the average would not be below that figure, the loss to the retail trade of Quebec would be equal to half a million of dollars. It is thought, however, that the loss of this custom will fall to a great extent on the larger and stronger class of retailers who are better able to stand it. On the other hand, the traders of Ottawa, being fewer in number, will be largely benefited, and a general revival of activity and prospective prosperity is evident there.
