

MOTORISTS, PLEASE GIVE ATTEN-TION.

At a meeting of the Executive Committee of The Newfoundland Motor Association, held on Tuesday last, it was unanimously decided to publish August 2nd, 1920. augs, si the following extracts from the By-Laws of the Association with the idea of advocating sane and considerate driving of motor vehicles. Members of the Association (and other drivers) are respectfully asked to cut out this article until such time as they have familiarized themselves with the fol-

> 1. Members of the Association must use the following hand signals:-

If stopping, slowing down, or turning out of the road, right hand held out horizontally. If the drive is left hand, left hand held out.

. 2. Any Motorist Member of the Asand the driver of the car ahead shall signal that he has heard the horn by An Emergency Meeting of answering two blasts.
