#### WILL EXAMINE "VETS" IN PENITENTIARIES

Authorities To Ascertain Mental Status of All Returned Men Serving Time.

Canadian Press Despatch. Ottawa, Sept. 3.-Following a reuest by C. G. MacNeil, secretary Dominion command, G.W.V.A., General W. S. Hughes, superintendent of Canadian penitentiaries, has directed the surgeon at each institution to onduct an examination of returned oldier inmates, in order to ascertain their mental condition. The move is in line with action in the U.S., where, in Wisconsin, above 50 per cent of the veterans in the penal in-stitutions were mentally abnormal, and where 20 per cent of these men were suffering from some mental dis-ability directly traceable to military

The result of the survey of exsoldier inmates of Canadian prisons is being awaited by the G. W. V. A. with intense interest and in cases where doubt exists, alienists will be called in to determine the exact
