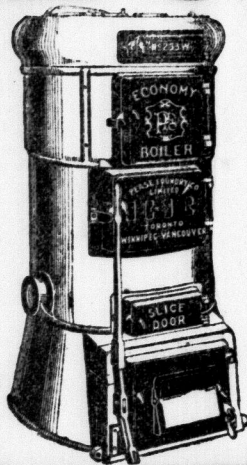

DOWLERS LIMITED MARKS EXPANSION

New Provincial Charter Permits Firm To Operate in Large Field.

Extensive changes have been granted by the provincial government in a charter, under which the firm of R. H. & J. Dowler, Limited, with head offices in London, is operating. The old name, which has been found cumbersome for advertising and other purposes, has been altered to the simpler form of "Dowlers, Limited."

The firm is now authorized to engage in practically any line of retail merchandizing. Speaking to The Advertiser last evening, R. H. Dowler, president, said that while no immediate expansion into other fields than that of clothing was contemplated, in the future such would undoubtedly be the case. The charter also authorizes the establishment of their own factories.

The change marks another step in the career of the Dowler brothers, who began with a single store in St. Thomas, but are now operating five stores in as many cities. They are now counted among the leading clothing men of the Dominion, and an even greater expansion is hoped for in the future.

DIRECT ENGINE LINE HARLAN-WINDSOR PLAN

Railway Officials Consider Running Engines Through From Harlan To Windsor.

St. Thomas, Oct. 6.—It was learned in this city today that an important meeting was held at Buffalo last week of railroad officials to consider the advisability of running the engines through from Harlan to Windsor. Harlan is a railroad center outside of New York, where the through trains are taken over by the electric engines for passage through the metropolis.

In discussing the situation, prominent railroad men state that it will not vitally affect the local situation, except in the shops. Some of the repair work will no doubt be transferred to the terminals. The engine crews will be changed in this city, and much of the station work continued.

Court Rules Dog May Bite Once

Magistrate Claims Dog Entitled One Bite Before Vicious.

Canadian Press Despatch. Windsor, Oct. 6.—Acting on the assumption that "every dog has its day," Magistrate Gundy this morning ruled that a dog is entitled to one bite before entering the category of a vicious animal.

This decision was reached in the case of the police vs. Joseph Poonessa, who was accused of keeping a vicious dog, said animal having bitten an unidentified woman.

Mrs. Cromar and her 16-year-old daughter testified that Poonessa's place was overrun with canines that snapped and barked at passers-by. "The dog that bit one of my neighbors," Mrs. Cromar said, "snapped through the grass like a snake, and then jumped at me."

"Well, the woman who is said to have been bitten is not here, and I cannot make a conviction because, according to Canadian law, every dog is entitled to one bite before it can be considered vicious," was the court's ruling.

THREE MEN IN ROWBOAT FOUND OFF PACIFIC COAST

WINDSOR BOY INJURED WHEN HIT BY AUTOMOBILE

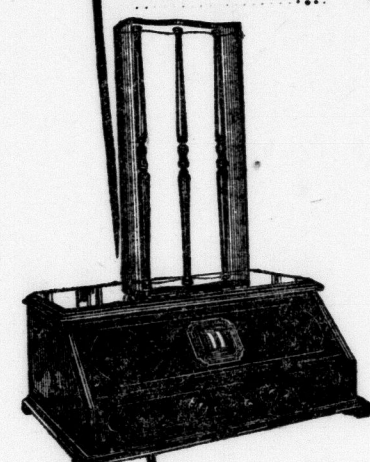

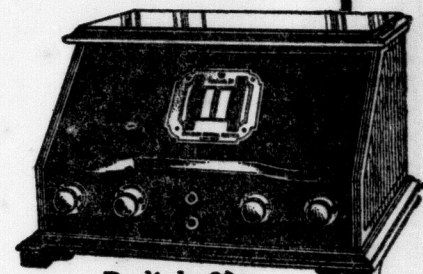

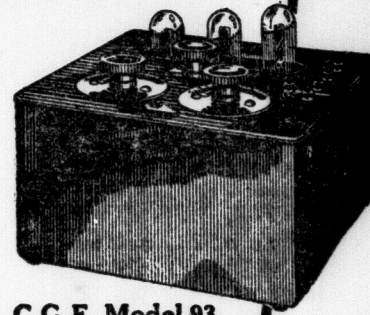
