INDICATIVE MOOD.

Present Tense.

Sing.

Neouubeeg, he causes me to see.
 Geouubeēg, he causes you to see.
 Oouubeēgon, he causes him to see.

Plu.

Neouubeēgoonuun, he causes us to see.
 Geouubeēgoouu, he causes you to see.
 Oouubeēgoouun, he causes them to see.

Imperfect.

Sing.

Neouubeēgoonuubun, he caused me to see.
 Geounbeēgoonuubun, he caused you to see.
 Oouubeēgoobun, he caused him to see.

Plu.

Neouubeegomenuubun, he caused us to see.
 Geouubeēgoouubun, he caused you to see.
 Oouubeēgobuneen, he caused them to see.

The Perfect and Pluperfect formed as usual.

Future.

Sing.

Nenguouubeēg, he shall cause me to see.
 Gegououubeēg, he shall cause you to see.
 Ooguouubeēgon, he shall cause him to see.

Plu.

Nenguouubeēgoouu, he shall cause us to see.
 Gegououubeēgoouu, he shall cause you to see.
 Ooguouubeēgoouun, he shall cause them to see.
