

The usual very useful General Index and an Index of Subjects will be found in the volume, and a large number of entries, which seemed to the Editor to stand in need of elucidation or explanation, have been carefully annotated, either Bibliographically or Historically, and collations of many of the books have also been given.

In the preface to this new volume the editor gives the usual survey of the value of the gross sales, the chief characteristics of the books sold, and a report of the average value of the lots founded on actual sales. He also draws attention to the changes which are taking place in the tastes of collectors, and to the classes of books which are now maintaining or losing their market value, and foretells what is likely to be in vogue in future: notably such works as those issued by the Kelmscott Press.

It is a noteworthy fact that, comparing the last ten volumes, the average price of the lots sold has been higher in 1899 than in any former year.

Subscribers to *Book-Prices Current* will be glad to hear that the proposed General Index to the first ten volumes is in hand, and that it is hoped that it will be issued during the year 1900.

A General Index will be issued shortly for the first ten volumes of the *Book-Prices Current*.

All the early volumes of the *Book-Prices Current* are out-of-print, and nearly all the volumes of the last years sell at a premium.
