fate was a hard, cruel and melancholy one, and that those who imposed such punishment upon a fellow-creature deserve the scorn and reproach of posterity. His history we shall never know conclusively, for the secret died with his gaolers, and there is no reason to believe that the hidden records of his past will ever open their pages and allow future generations to settle definitely who really was "The Man in the Iron Mask."
