

where:

A = The support provided by the federal and provincial governments to producers of barley through the SIAP for that calendar year

$\sum_{i=1}^{10} B_i$ = The summation of the support provided in each province by the federal and provincial governments to producers of barley through the SIAP for that calendar year

where:

$$B_i = (C_i + D_i) * \frac{E_i}{F_i}$$

where:

C_i = the support provided by the federal government to that province through the SIAP for that calendar year

D_i = the direct support provided by the provincial government through the SIAP for that calendar year

E_i = the basis for payment in that province for barley

F_i = the basis for payment in that province for all eligible commodities.

5.4 Payments Pursuant to the Net Income Stabilization Program (NISA)

The support provided by the federal and provincial governments to producers of barley through the Net Income Stabilization Account is the amount of the total support provided under the program to producers of barley. The support is computed in accordance with the following formula:

$$A = B * \frac{C}{D}$$
