WIN Exports (World Information Network for Exports)

All Canadian companies who are exporting or who have the capacity to export can also register in WIN Exports, the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade's (DFAIT) computerized database of exporters. WIN can only be accessed by DFAIT's Trade Commissioners around the world, Team Canada Inc partners and International Trade Centers. It is used to match Canadian firms with international business opportunities. All registrants also receive the CanadExport newsletter, published bi-monthly, with articles on trade issues and export opportunities. To register in WIN Exports call the hot line at 1-800-551-4946.
