at the play, your nights in gambling, and your mornings in bed; that your counsellors were men of no abilities, that you were laterally deaf to all falutary information, and that your gallantries employed most of your time: if, I say, Sir, these things are true, there exists not a delinquent on the sace of the earth so deserving of exemplary punishment as yourself.

In recollecting this your ever memorable speech, the speeches of the rest of the minority are naturally brought to my remembrance. These uniformly antiministerial members are doubtless all honourable men. The nation is persectly convinced of their sincerity, and that places or pensions are no part
