Every incorporated company which enters into any such combination, agreement or arrangement as in the next preceding section mentioned, and has been convicted of a misdemeanor under the provisions thereof, shall thereby forfeit its corporate rights and franchises, so far as the same have been conferred by or exist in virtue of any law in Canada. 5
