

The names of the authors of the articles in this book have been taken from J. W. Wardie's ^{of another copy} copy, ^{as Wardie's plates} and the property of Caroline Doumet.

There is no doubt that the names pencilled in that copy were written by Dr. J. F. L. Doumet, Surgeon, H.M.S. "Assistance", 1850-51, editor of the "Annals Bohealis", issued on board the "Assistance". The present book is composed of articles selected from the "Annals Bohealis".

I have added a few notes myself, so that the details given are not in every case confined to those given in J. W. Wardie's copy.

"J. D." are Doumet's initials. C.R. Warham used at least two pseudonyms. "Examinis" identity is not mentioned by Doumet.

The original copy, belonging to a Mr. Gale & once belonging to Caroline Doumet, is in the Scott Polar Research Institute, Cambridge. She was Dr. Doumet's sister.
