



EAST STREET, ST. THOMAS.--The roadway is twenty-two feet wide, curbed with 3x10 cedar and made of crushed stone ten inches in depth at the centre and seven at the curb after consolidation with a heavy road roller. The sidewalks are four feet wide, of pine. The street was improved in 1895, and the above photograph taken May, 1896.
