8—The Treasurer of the County shall publish in some newspaper or newspapers published in the County, twice in each year, namely: in the first week of April and the first week of October the names of all persons licensed under this By law the territory for which the licenses have been issued, and the dates on which such licenses will expire.

9—By laws numbered 280, 375 and 406 being By laws relating to licensing, regulating and governing Auctioneers are hereby repealed except in so far as they relate to licenses issued under the provisions of said By law No 280 which have not yet expired and no By law thereby repealed shall be hereby revived

#### BY LAW No 420.

A By law to provide for the licensing, regulating and governing of Hawkers  
Pedlars and Petty Chapmen.

Whereas in pursuance of the provisions of "The Municipal Act" it is  
expedient and necessary to provide for the licensing regulating and governing  
of Hawkers, Pedlars and Petty Chapmen within the county of Victoria

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the County of Victoria enacts  
as follows:

1—That from and after the passing of this By law it shall not be lawful  
for Hawkers Petty Chapmen and other persons carrying on petty trade or  
who go from place to place or to other men's houses, on foot or with any  
animal, bearing or drawing any goods, wares or merchandise for sale or  
or in or with any boat vessel or other craft, or otherwise carrying goods wares or
