

ARTICLE VI.

Persons joining the Society shall pay Five Shillings—and Three Shillings shall be paid Quarterly by each Member, from which last sum One Shilling may be deducted towards defraying the Evening's Expences.

ARTICLE VII.

Duty of
the Com-
mittee of
Six

Two of the Committee of Six shall serve monthly—visit the Jail at least once a week, examine minutely into the situation and wants of the Prisoners confined for Debt, and apply the Funds of the Society to their relief—in cases where their aid or advice may be necessary, they may ask the assistance of the Officers of the Society.

ARTICLE VIII.

Accounts

The Treasurer shall render his ac-
