GUIDE NEWS FROM SANTIAGO

Commodore Schley Believes He Has the Spaniards in a Trap.

By Clever Maneuvering He Enticed Cervera Into Santiago—Cruiser St. Paul Captures a Coal Ship—Intense Heat in Cuban Waters—Steel Turrets Too Hot to Work In.

Mole St. Nicholas, Haiti, May 30.—The following dispatch has been received here from the correspondent of the Associated Press with the text of the report of Commodore Schley's movements in the harbor of Santiago de Cuba, May 20.—Commodore Schley and the flying squadron have the Spaniards bottled up in the harbor of Santiago de Cuba. By the most magnificent feat of arms the Commodore has lured the Spaniards to think he had led in disgust. They took the bait and ran into the harbor. Commodore Schley moved down this morning, and at 6 o'clock, going close to the harbor, he saw the Cristobal Colon, the American ship here, and the Spanish fleet. He believes the entire fleet is there.
