PLANNING MILLS DESTROYED

Property of Brennan & Sons in Hamilton Burned to the Ground.

The loss is estimated at \$50,000.

Hamilton, July 11.—Within two days the fire department has been called to fight two of the worst fires of the year, the second breaking out at the Brennan & Sons' planning mills, Nos. 82 to 100 King William-street, about nine o'clock to-night. The fire was discovered by the night watchman, T. Nixon, who promptly turned in an alarm. He saw the blaze first in the engine-room, but by the time the department arrived it had spread to the mill. When the flames burst thru the roof the spectacular effect was great, millions of sparks falling around the buildings in the vicinity have gravel roofs, else the loss would have been much greater.

TOO BUSY TO CLOSE.

Central Stock Exchange Will Be Open Thru the Heated Term.

Montreal, July 11.—For the first time in many years the afternoon session of the Montreal Stock Exchange during the heated term will not be discontinued. The motion to close the exchanges in the afternoons and Saturdays, the custom usually followed in the summer months, was brought up this morning and, as expected, was defeated. In the last year or so a great many young men have been selected to the exchange and they are sure its members will be pleased to avail themselves of the opportunity to attend the forthcoming convention.
