Eleventh Annual Meeting, 1898.



THE Annual Meeting of the Corporation of this Institution was held at Hillcrest Convalescent Home on Friday, the 28th of October; Mr. O. Howland presiding, in the place of His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor, who was unable to be present.
