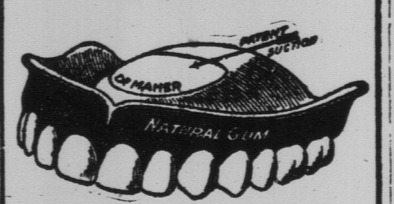

WEST INDIAN SYRIANS HELP RELIEF FUND The Syrians of Kingston, Jamaica, have recently raised the sum of \$2,300 to be used in relief work among Christians and Jews in Syrian Palestine.

This money has been cabled abroad through the American Committee for Armenian and Syrian Relief, 1 Madison avenue, New York, with \$2,500 additional which the committee will devote to relief in that section.

Two smaller contributions received by the committee are of special interest. Five dollars came from a civil war veteran on his seventy-ninth birthday. He wrote that he knew what hunger means as "I have had to march and fight on a ration of one ear of parched corn."

Another check for \$50 was received from a preacher who had been sixty years a missionary among the American Indians.
