1. CLASSICS.

LATIN.

FIRST YEAR—*Ovid*. Selections.*Cicero*. De Amicitia.Prose Composition, *Harkness*, I.

Roman History to death of Augustus.

Ancient Geography and Antiquities.

(Five hours a week.)

SECOND YEAR—*Virgil*. Bucolics.*Livy*. Book V.*Juvenal*. Satires I., III., X.Prose Composition, *Harkness*, II.

(Four hours a week.)

GREEK.

FIRST YEAR—*Xenophon*. Selections from Cyropedia.*Homer*, Iliad, Book I.*Greek Testament*. St. Mark's Gospel.Prose Composition, *Arnold*, 1 to 40.

(Four hours a week.)

SECOND YEAR—*Euripides*. Alcestis.*Plato*. Apology and Crito.Prose Composition, *Arnold*, 40 to end, 1st Part.

Greek History, to death of Alexander.

Grecian Antiquities.
