Referring your letter to Mr  
A. D. Moore Indian Agent Cape Croker.  
file 27027-1 April 4th 1928.  
When I enter my claim to your Dept  
to Scugog Island purchase land you  
were wanted me to produce some  
document that would support my  
claim. In 1843 when the Mississauga  
Indians of Scugog purchase the eight-  
hundred acre of land they borrow the  
annuity funds from the band at Ined  
lake and Rice lake. When the land  
was paid for the deed to the Indians  
was given to the Indian Department of  
Indian Affairs for safe keeping. The  
Indians who bought the land left their  
former occupation and came from  
Indian point and Balsome lake to Scugog.  
The names of the Indians who came at  
that time to occupy the land were as  
follows. John Elliott Dan Elliott Abner  
Elliott
