The advanced theoretical instruction is given either at the beginning or end of the working-day, in order not to break up the time allotted to practical work. During this year the student is required to prepare a thesis on some subject connected with his work. The practical examinations are held by the School, while the written examinations and the examination of the theses are held by the University. After complying with all requirements, the candidate receives from the University the degree of Bachelor of Applied Science (B. A. Sc.)

PROFESSIONAL DEGREES.

Bachelors of Applied Science may, after three years spent in professional work, present themselves for the degrees of Civil Engineer (C.E.), Mining Engineer (M.E.), Mechanical Engineer (M.E.) or Electrical Engineer (E.E.), as the case may be, subject to the rules and regulations established by the University.
