## BILL.

“ An Act to enable the Corporation of the Mayor and  
“ Councillors of the City of Quebec, to borrow an  
“ additional sum for the construction of the Water  
“ Works.”

**W**HEREAS the Corporation of the Mayor and Coun-  
cillors of the City of Quebec have by their Petition Preamble.  
represented that it is necessary to enable them properly to  
carry into effect the Act passed by the Legislative Council  
5 and Legislative Assembly in the ninth, and assented to by  
Her Majesty in the tenth year of Her Reign, and intituled,  
“ An Act for supplying the City of Quebec and parts adjacent  
“ thereto with water;” and the Act amending the same, passed  
in the session held in the thirteenth and fourteenth years of  
10 Her Majesty’s Reign, and intituled, “ An Act to amend an  
“ Act for supplying the City of Quebec and parts adjacent  
“ thereto with water;” and have prayed for authority to enable  
them to borrow an additional sum of Fifty thousand pounds  
current money of this Province, and for authority to increase  
15 the rate or assessment to be levied under and by virtue of said  
acts to the uniform rate of one shilling and six pence currency,  
upon the annual assessed value of all property within the said  
City; and whereas it is expedient to grant their prayer.

Be it therefore enacted, by the Queen’s Most Excellent  
20 Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative  
Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of  
Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the  
authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United  
Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, “ *An*  
25 “ *Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower-Ca-*  
“ *nada, and for the Government of Canada,*” and it is  
hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that it  
shall and may be lawful for the said Corporation to  
borrow an additional sum of money not exceeding Fifty  
30 thousand pounds, making altogether a sum of One hun-  
dred and seventy five thousand pounds current money of this  
Province, for the purpose of establishing the said Water Works,  
and to issue Debentures or Corporation Bonds, to that amount,  
under the hand of the Mayor and the seal of the said Corpo-  
35 ration, payable on the first day of November, in the year of  
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy, unless the  
said Corporation shall see fit to redeem the same at an earlier  
period, with the consent of the holders thereof; upon which  
Debentures or Corporation Bonds interest shall be payable  
40 semi-annually on the first day of November and May in every  
year, which interest may amount to and shall not exceed the

more, making
