

An Act to encourage Mining Companies by empowering them to construct tramways of ten miles in length to connect with railways and navigable waters.

WHEREAS it is advisable to afford every encouragement to the development of the Mineral wealth of Canada; Therefore Her Majesty, &c. : Preamble.

1. The proprietors of any Mine in Canada shall have power to construct a tramway from their Mines to the nearest navigable waters or railway, and shall be vested with power to take any land required for right of way and stations at a fair valuation, under the provisions of the eleventh section of the Railway Clauses Consolidation Act, in that behalf, headed "Lands and their Valuation," which shall apply to such proprietors, and through any Crown Lands *gratis*, provided the said tramway shall not exceed ten miles in length. Power to proprietors of mines to construct a Tramway in certain cases.
