

La Plaine 18th April 1868.

Dear Sir

Along with this you will receive an official Letter on the Subject of Damaged Stores - Should the Governor think proper to order them to be stored in separate Warehouses for the Goods belonging to each Province (in B. & D.) will be required.

I have received your Letter containing a General Statement, of Indian Goods in the Possession of Mr Jacques at Quebec on the 24th March 1868. - On comparing the same, with an Account Mr Jacques gave me, on the 21st Oct. find in it, the Differences mentioned on the other side. - There may no doubt have been made between those Lists, but an Account of them, should have been transmitted with the above Statement, to enable me to account for the Differences made to exist. - The 24th of last Month was the time Mr J should have made up his Quarterly Accounts of Goods if there were any.

I am not sure but the General may decline giving any Direction, respecting the Canada. - Mr John however says, that he has the whole of the Department under his Direction & consequently I have made the above application to him, instead of Gov Gen. - I am with great regard
