MEMORANDUM

Mr. King:

Beam Wireless Telegraphic Messages  
Australia and Canada

Mr. Baldwin telephoned to say that the Marconi Company is inaugurating a Beam Wireless Telegraphy service between Australia and Canada, and Tasmania and Canada; that the messages which it is proposed to have sent by Premier Bruce and the Premier of Tasmania to you have been received at your Office over the ordinary cable. The actual inauguration will be done to-morrow. A cabled request has come from Australia for an advance copy, to be sent by ordinary cable, of the acknowledgment which you will send to Australia and Tasmania. Mr. Baldwin is consulting Dr. Skelton, whose approval he will secure of the draft messages. The Marconi Company ask that the messages which you will send by the Beam System to-morrow be cabled to Australia to-day.

Mr. Baldwin asks if you will let him know when he may submit the draft messages to you. Dr. Skelton thinks that you need not be bothered personally concerning the matter; but as the messages are to be sent over your signature, Mr. Baldwin thinks you will wish to approve them after Dr. Skelton has passed on them.
