

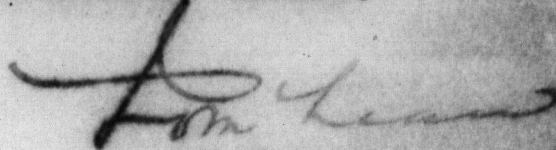

You are aware that the said rental is also for the privilege of constructing and using a wagon road across the Oxford Bay Indian reserve, No.4.
