



Rev. Sir:-

In view of the report contained in your letter of the 12th instant, I beg to say that the Department approves of an expenditure of \$ 100.00 being incurred in the erection of a house for Noel Labobe. The best possible results should be obtained from the expenditure now authorized, in order that the Indians generally may be incited to improve their dwellings whenever possible. It is thought that the majority of them should be able to make necessary repairs or erect new dwellings without aid from the Department.
