Re: Miss Sarah Freeman

Mr. Superintendent Findlay's report on the circumstances leading up to the resignation of the above mentioned teacher from the Masset Indian Day School indicates that Miss Freeman had some difficulty in working with the other members of the staff. It is my opinion that Miss Freeman would fit in best in a one room school. I am a little concerned about transferring her to Port Simpson where I feel that we might have a repetition of the occurrence at Masset. If Mrs. Campbell's medical report indicates that she is unable to return to her duties at Kitkatla I feel that Miss Freeman would be best employed at that point. If this is not possible I am prepared to recommend that she be employed at Port Simpson for the remainder of the current academic year only.
