
## Zeiss Levels Nos. II and III, with Stands.



Large Level, similar in its general design to the No. I Level, except that it has a gradienter screw and lever for setting the bubble accurately and with ease. The instrument is mounted on a detachable tripod. It attaches to the stand by means of a central screw without a spring. The stand, which weighs only 9 lbs, is exceedingly rigid and has self-retaining legs. The instrument is available for levelling operations demanding the highest degree of accuracy, for taking an extensive series of readings from a single station, and for purely scientific purposes. The free aperture of the object glass is 35 mm (1<sup>8</sup>/<sub>8</sub>") and 45 mm (1<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>") respectively, and the instrument has a magnifying power of 28 and 35 diameters respectively.
