BRITTON. A village on the G B and L E div G T Ry, in Elma township, Perth County, 20 miles north of Stratford, the county seat, and 5 south of Listowel, the nearest bank location. Settled in 1880. It contains a Methodist church and a public school, and ships wood, live stock, hay, cheese and produce. Stage to Hammond three times a week. Population, 70. Mail daily. Joseph Freeman, postmaster.

BROADBENT. A country post office on the East Seguin river (which furnishes power) in McKellar township, Parry Sound district, 20 miles north-east of Parry Sound, the nearest shipping point, and 64 from Midland on the G T R, the nearest banking point. Settled in 1870. It has an Episcopal church and common school, and ships flour and lumber. Population, 50. Mail weekly. Thomas Patterson, postmaster.

Broadbent H & E, saw, shingle and flour mills.

BROCK ROAD. A small place on the C V line C P Ry in Halton County. Post office name Puslinch, which see for directory.

BROCKTON. A post office and former suburb of Toronto, but now incorporated with that city and known as St Mark's ward (for names see Toronto). Thomas Banks, postmaster.

BROCKVILLE. An incorporated town on the St Lawrence river, and on the G T Ry, and the terminus of the B & O br C P Ry, in Elizabethtown township, Leeds County, of which it is the county seat. Settled in 1790, and incorporated in 1832. It has several manufactories, and contains 2 Episcopal, 2 Methodist, 2 Presbyterian, and Catholic, Congregational and Baptist churches, 5 public schools, an opera house seating 1,000, a town hall seating 600, 2 banks and 2 daily newspapers, the *Times* and the *Recorder*, which also publish weekly editions, and the weekly

Monitor. Grain, live stock and produce, and the products of its manufactories are shipped. Assessed valuation of real and personal property, \$2,500,000, bonded indebtedness, \$38,100. It is lighted with gas, has waterworks, a volunteer fire department, and telephone communication. It is a port of call for all river steamers, and ferries run frequently to Morriston, US, on the opposite bank of the St Lawrence. Stages daily to Westport, Toledo and Frankville. Population, 10,000. Telegraph, GNW. Express, Canadian. Mail daily. Distance from Toronto, 208 miles, from Montreal, 125 miles. Wm Fitzsimmons, postmaster.
