

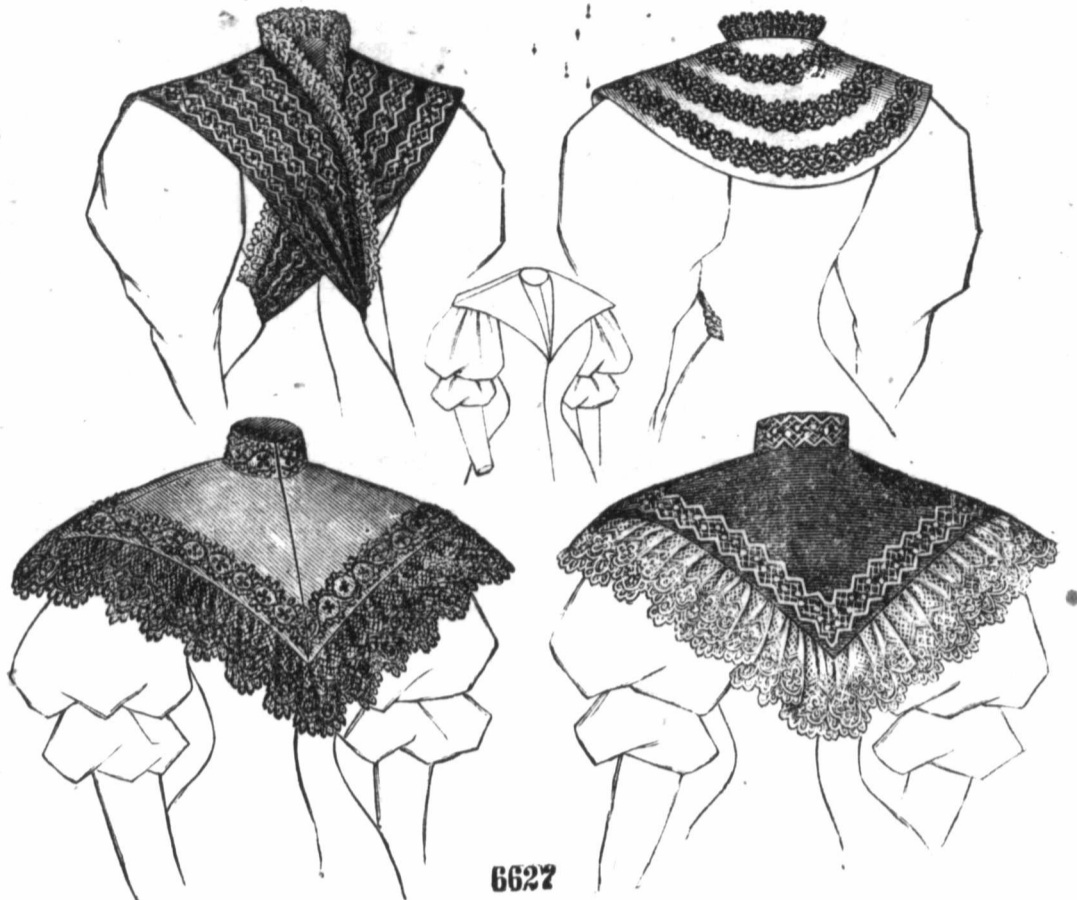

LADIES' DOUBLE-BREASTED COAT-BASQUE, WITH CIRCULAR RIPPLE SKIRT SEWED ON. (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 6635.—By referring to figure No. 243 G on page 4, a different view of this basque may be observed. The pattern is in 13 sizes for ladies from 28 to 46 inches, bust measure. To make the basque for a lady of medium size, will require  $7\frac{1}{4}$  yards of material 22 inches wide, or  $3\frac{3}{8}$  yards 44 inches wide, or  $3\frac{5}{8}$  yards 50 inches wide. Price of pattern, 30 cents.

LADIES' FANCY FICHU AND CAPE-COLLAR. (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 6627.—In the engravings are represented two dainty accessories. The cape collar is portrayed developed in cloth and decorated with *point de Gène* insertion and edging. The front view of the fichu shows it made of dark and the back view of light dress goods, insertion and edging supplying the garniture in each instance. The pattern is in 3 sizes, small, medium and large. In the medium size, the fichu will require 1 yard of material 22 inches wide, or 1 yard 27 inches or more in width. The cape collar needs 1 yard of goods 22 inches wide, or  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard either 44 or 50 inches wide. Price of pattern, 10 cents.

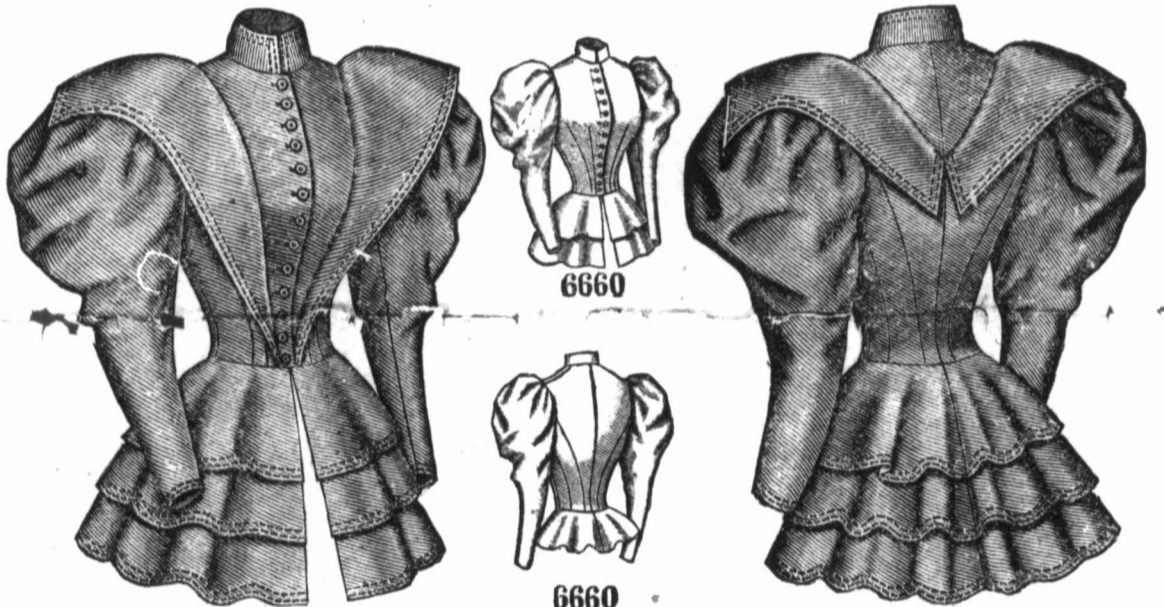

PATTERN FOR A CAT. (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 6668.—This cat, without which no well regulated menagerie would be complete, may be made of long-haired black fur, Canton flannel, etc. The pattern is in 3 sizes for cats from 7 to 11 inches in height. A cat 9 inches high, requires  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of material 27 inches wide, or  $\frac{3}{8}$  yard 36 inches wide. Price, 10 cents.

LADIES' BASQUE. (TO BE MADE WITH ONE, TWO OR THREE RIPPLE SKIRTS.) (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 6660.—This basque is shown very attractively developed in serge of a fashionable shade of green, and simply, though tastefully, completed with an edge finish of two rows of machine-stitching. If a less dressy effect be desired, the basque may be made up without the revers, as shown in the small illustrations, where it is also illustrated made with one and two ripple skirts. The pattern is in 13 sizes for ladies from 28 to 46 inches, bust measure. To make the basque of one material for a lady of medium size, will need  $7\frac{3}{4}$  yards 22 inches wide, or  $4\frac{1}{8}$  yards 44 inches wide. If goods 50 inches wide be selected,  $3\frac{3}{8}$  yards will suffice. Price of pattern, 30 cents.

LADIES' COSTUME, WITH THREE-PIECE SKIRT. (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 6657.—At figure No. 227 G on page 5 of this issue a different representation of this costume may be observed. The pattern is in 13 sizes for ladies from 28 to 46 inches, bust measure. To make the costume of one material for a lady of medium size, will require  $18\frac{1}{4}$  yards 22 inches wide, or  $7\frac{1}{4}$  yards 44 inches wide. If goods 50 inches wide be selected, then  $6\frac{1}{4}$  yards will suffice. Price of pattern, 35 cents.

LITTLE GIRLS' HAT. (KNOWN AS THE COLONIAL HAT.) (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 6667.—The pattern of this quaint little hat is in 4 sizes for little girls from 1 to 7 years of age. To make the hat for a girl of 5 years, requires 2 yards of material 20 inches wide, or  $1\frac{1}{2}$  yard 44 inches wide. In either instance  $\frac{5}{8}$  yard of lining silk 20 inches wide is needed to line. Price, 10 cents.

LADIES' CAPE. (TO BE MADE IN THREE-QUARTER OR SHORTER LENGTHS.) (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 6639.—The pattern of this cape is in 10 sizes for ladies from 28 to 46 inches, bust measure. For a lady of medium size, the cape with cape ruffle calls for  $11\frac{3}{4}$  yards of material 22 inches wide, or  $6\frac{1}{2}$  yards 44 inches wide, or  $5\frac{3}{4}$  yards 54 inches wide. The cape without cape ruffle requires  $7\frac{3}{4}$  yards 22 inches wide, or  $4\frac{1}{4}$  yards 44 inches wide. If goods 54 inches wide be chosen,  $3\frac{3}{8}$  yards will be sufficient. Price of pattern, 30 cents.
