George Montgomery West Carey was born in Belfast, Ireland, March 10th, 1829, received his early education at the Moravian village, Gracehill, Belfast, and when a small boy came out to Canada with his parents. He attended the Grammar School at Vankleek, entered the University of Rochester, New York, took the degree of B. A. there, and proceeded to graduation in theology and to M. A. in course. He was admitted M. A. ad evindem in Acadia College, N. S., and to the same standing in the Bapt'st College, Toronto. Dr. Carev held the certificate of President Harper of the University of Chicago for having successfully completed the advanced course in Hebrew. In 1894 he was made D. D. by Acadia.
