

## MARKETS AND FINANCE

### Toronto Markets

#### LIVE STOCK.

Receipts of live stock at the Union Stock Yards were 98 car loads, consisting of 1,981 cattle, 13 hogs, 225 sheep and lambs, and 1,300 calves.

The quality of fat calves was good, especially the export class, of which there were some loads of extra quality.

Trade was slow, but considering the heavy deliveries last week, prices for good quality cattle held up fairly well, but the common grades were easier.

Exporters.—There was nothing doing in the way of selling exporters, drivers waiting for Tuesday's market, when the buyers of this class will be on hand.

Butchers.—Prime picked lots were quoted by one of the heaviest buyers at \$5.50 to \$6.70; loads of good, \$5.20 to \$5.50, and one load at \$5.60; medium, \$4.80 to \$5.10; common, \$4 to \$4.50, cows, \$3.25 to \$4.70.

Milk and springers.—Receipts of milkers and springers were moderate and prices also were reported to be moderate, and prices also were reported to be moderate, more or less at any time this season. Fred Rovinsky bought the bulk of the milkers and springers, 15 in number, at \$25 to \$45 each.

Veal calves.—No. 1 calves were on sale and prices were unchanged at \$3 to \$6 per cwt.

Sheep and lambs.—Receipts of 225 sheep and lambs, found ready sale and more could have been sold. Export ewes, \$3.50 to \$4.12; lambs, \$2.50 to \$3.50 per cwt.; lambs, the bulk sold at \$5.50 to \$7.50 per cwt., and one lot of extra choice brought \$8 per cwt., or 8c per lb.

Hogs.—Market for hogs is firm at \$6.15 per cwt. for select, fed and watered, and \$7.90, f.o.b., cars, at country points.
