AFTERNOON PARK CONCERNS.

Mayor Taylor referred to the fact that Lieut.-Col. Smith, of "D" Company, I. S. C., had offered to give band concerts during the summer months free of charge one afternoon a week at Victoria Park from 4 to 6 o'clock provided that the Council would pay for advertisement regarding the same. Accepted with thanks on motion of Ald. Moulie.

QUEEN'S PARK FOR PAVES.

The Mayor also referred to the necessity of improvements at Queen's Park. He suggested that a number of new seats be provided, a fountain erected, the place put in proper order and hot water be supplied with the use of the ground to all parties who desired to use it. He felt sure that many picnickers from outside places would use the park if it were fixed up thoroughly and free use granted. It was decided that the matter be referred to No. 2 Committee with power. Some of the sheds will be thrown open and made available in case of showers interrupting the picnickers.

TALBOT STREET WALK.

Squire Harvey spoke of the state of the sidewalk on the west side of Talbot street and the need of a new one. The residents would like a new sidewalk laid and moved out, as was done on the east side of the street. Other gentlemen, who came as a deputation, were heard on the same subject. They were: Messrs. S. J. Peters, Joseph Jeffery, L. Meredith, S. Gibson and Bartley.

It was suggested by Ald. Fitzgerald that Ald. O'Meara was to blame for the discrimination in the improvements in that section of the city.

Ald. O'Meara denied it hotly.

Ald. Anderson suggested that it be referred to the members of the ward as well as to No. 2 Committee, and that the same rule be used in all future cases. This created more talk, but it was finally referred to No. 2 Committee alone to deal with.

EXONERATED HIM.

That Is What the Board of Education Did With Mr. Learn.

Trustee Jeffery Explains His Position and Is Supported by the Board—Tenders for Talbot Street School Improvements Accepted—The New Trustees Take Their Seats.

A special meeting of the Board of Education was held in the Assessors' room, in the City Hall, last evening, for the purpose of letting the contracts for the improvements in connection with the Talbot street school; for the induction of the new trustees from South London, and also to investigate the charges brought against Mr. Learn, head master of King street school.

The following were the successful ones: Mr. Wm. Tyler, carpenter work, \$2,970; Mr. J. S. Loney, brick work, stone and concrete work, etc., \$3,190; T. Robinson, plastering, \$235; and A. H. Cook, painting, etc., \$235.

A communication was received from Mr. David Denny, asking for the position as clerk of the Board. Denny was appointed. The account of P. Dickenson for \$137.75 was ordered paid.

THE NEW TRUSTEES.

The next order of business was the introducing of Messrs. Dewar and Rowlands. They were warmly welcomed, and each made a short reply thanking the members for the cordial reception.

Mr. Dewar was appointed to No. 2 Committee and his colleague to No. 1.
