Hon. Dr. Borden read the message in the House this afternoon, and remarked: "Perhaps I may admit that while this is very sad news, there is to be taken out of it that Canada has earned its reputation in South Africa, and they continue to prefer death to surrender."

The portion of the Mounted Rifles which were killed in the battle of Tlokoeng, Monday, is that which sailed from Halifax on the troopship Manhattan on January 15, under command of Major Merritt, Toronto, and consisted of D. and E. squadrons, and the 4th troop of the 1st Mounted Rifles.

Kitchener's Despatch Tells of the Battle at Hart's River.

London, April 4.—There was severe fighting all day long on March 31 in the neighborhood of Hart's River, in the southwest extremity of the Orange Free State, between the forces of General Buller and the Boers.

The Canadian Rifles especially distinguished themselves, one party commanded by Lieut. Bruce Carruthers holding its position till every man was killed or wounded.
