Scientific and Useful.

REMOVE flower-pot stains from window sills by rubbing with fine wood ashes and rinse with clean water.

Do not cut lamp wicks, but trim them by wiping off with a scrap of paper.

ORDINARY newspapers are very impervious to cold. If apples are to be shipped during winter, line the barrels with two or three thicknesses of paper, and the apples will rarely freeze, if properly protected.

A VERY simple but often efficacious cure for bunions is a poultice of cold bread-and-water at night, and in the morning rub with olive oil, and place a small piece of gutta-percha tissue over the bunion to keep it moist.

A HANDSOME cover for a sofa-pillow is made by embroidering two strips of blue satin with pink rosebuds and some fine green foliage; alternate these strips with velvet or plush of a contrasting colour; a dark crimson is particularly pretty with the blue.

DELICATE SOUP.—Boil a small cup of rice in a little over a quart of milk. Boil until it is so soft that it will pass through a sieve. Grate the nicely bleached parts of two heads of celery and add to the strained rice; add to this one quart strong beef stock, or that made from mutton or veal may be used; it should be strained, and be clear and free from lumps when it is put in with the rice. Let this boil until the celery is tender. Season with a dash of cayenne pepper, or a little curry powder, and plenty of salt.

CONTACT PUDDING.—Three eggs, two cupfuls of pulverized sugar, four large teaspoonfuls of butter, half a pint of sweet milk, one pint of flour, and two teaspoonfuls of baking powder. Work the butter to the lightest possible cream, beat the eggs separately, and mix the pudding the same as in directions for cake making. Bake half an hour. This quantity will make two cakes of the proper size. There is no better recipe than this for this favourite pudding. To be served hot with sauce.

BREAKFAST DISHES.—An excellent dish is made of six eggs and three tablespoonfuls of ham chopped very fine; beat the eggs, and after melting a lump of butter in the frying-pan drop the eggs into it and stir the ham in; the ham has of course been cooked, either fried or boiled; season with pepper. This is a good way to use up pieces of meat that are left from dinner. A nice dish for breakfast or for tea is made of sweet potatoes boiled. Remove the skins, rub the potatoes through a coarse colander, make into flat cakes, dip into flour and fry in hot butter.

SAVOY CAKE.—The weight of four eggs in pounded loaf sugar, the weight of seven in flour, a little grated lemon peel or almond extract for flavouring. Break the seven eggs, putting the whites into one bowl and the yolks into another. Beat the yolks very light, and mix the sugar with them and the flavouring; beat them well together; then add the whites, which have been beaten to a froth. Put the flour in by degrees, and after it is all stirred in, keep on beating the dough for at least fifteen minutes. The cake should be baked in a loaf, and it will require from one hour and a quarter to one hour and a half for it to bake.
