EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to refer to your Note No. 19 of June 30, 1953, concerning the extension to the Colony of Dominica of the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom and the Government of Canada for the avoidance of double taxation and the prevention of fiscal evasion with respect to taxes on income dated June 5, 1946, and to confirm that the terms of the foregoing Note are acceptable to the Government of Canada.

Your Note and this reply will, therefore, constitute an agreement between our two governments on this subject.
