Assistance in the case of Nuclear Accident or Radiological Emergency, done on September 26, 1986;

INTENDING to co-operate with one another to these ends;

HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I

For the purpose of this Agreement:

- (a) "Appropriate governmental authorities" means for the United Mexican States, the Secretary of Energy, Mines and State-Owned Industry, which shall carry out its obligations by means of the National Commission of Nuclear Safety and Safeguards, and for Canada, the Atomic Energy Control Board;
- (b) "Equipment" means any of the equipment listed in Annex A to this Agreement;
- (c) "Material" means any of the material listed in Annex B to this Agreement;
- "Nuclear material" means any source material or any special fissionable material as these terms are defined in Article XX of the Statute of the Agency, which are included in Annex C to this Agreement. Any determination by the Board of Governors of the Agency under Article XX of the Agency's Statute that amends the list of material considered to be "source material" or "special fissionable material" shall only have effect under this Agreement when the Parties to this Agreement have informed each other in writing that they accept that determination;
