The Minister of Veterans Affairs—On Thursday next—In Committee of the Whole at the next sitting—The following proposed Resolution, which has been recommended to the House by His Excellency:—

Resolved, That it is expedient to introduce a measure to amend the War Veterans Allowance Act, 1952, to increase the monthly rates of certain allowances and permissible income; to extend the provisions of the Act to additional classes of veterans, widows and orphans; and to increase the salaries of the members of the War Veterans Allowance Board.

The Minister of Veterans Affairs—On Thursday next—In Committee of the Whole at the next sitting—The following proposed Resolution, which has been recommended to the House by His Excellency:—

Resolved, That it is expedient to introduce a measure to amend the Pension Act to place dependants of persons who served in World War II in a position comparable to that of dependants of persons who served in World War I in cases of disability or death due to improper conduct; to ensure that pensions may be paid to the dependants of deceased members of the forces resident and domiciled in Newfoundland; to provide for the continuation of disability pensions and widows' pensions to the end of the month in which death occurred except in cases where no additional pension for dependants is payable; to provide for the payment of pension to the daughter of a pensioned widower where the domestic establishment is maintained after his death; to provide for an increase in the clothing allowance on account of amputation or use of appliances; to provide for an increase in the allowances for funeral and burial expenses; to remove the limitation on the amount of pension payable to a dependent parent of a deceased pensioner after discontinuance of pension to other dependants; to authorize payment of widows' pensions at current rates upon reinstatement of discontinued pensions; and to remove the limitation on payment of pensions to or in respect of children born after a specified date, or to wives whose marriage to a member of the forces or a pensioner took place after a specified date; such measure to include, in addition, certain consequential and clarifying amendments.
