One of these parts covers strictly city traffic; the other inter-municipal traffic when it reaches the city limits. The former is the bigger section of the franchise to-day, years beyond-1921. If the company should be successful in splitting its franchise and in having them expire at different dates, it would virtually remain in possession of the whole franchise for forty years at least, and perhaps for a much longer period. With the Toronto Railway Company in possession of the 'etter half of the franchise in 1921, bow could the city seil to advantage the remaining interest? If the grab is allowed to go thru, good-bye forever to the idea of civic operation of the street railway. It is just possible that part of the franchise which expires in 1921 might thru the manipulation of the company, become a white elephant, in-

stead of an asset, on the city's hands. We have already shown, in Saturday's issue, that there is absolutely no reason why the franchise should be divided. 
