St. Petersburg, July 7.-The government is seriously trying to calm the country by distributing everywhere copies of Prince Troubetskoy's zemstvo address, with the emperor's response. A million copies have been printed and systematically spread by the provincial governors to the cities and country. Besides this, the emperor has personally commissioned Count Ignatieff, who is the head of the religious toleration commission, to tour the country, address the people and pacify them in his name.






