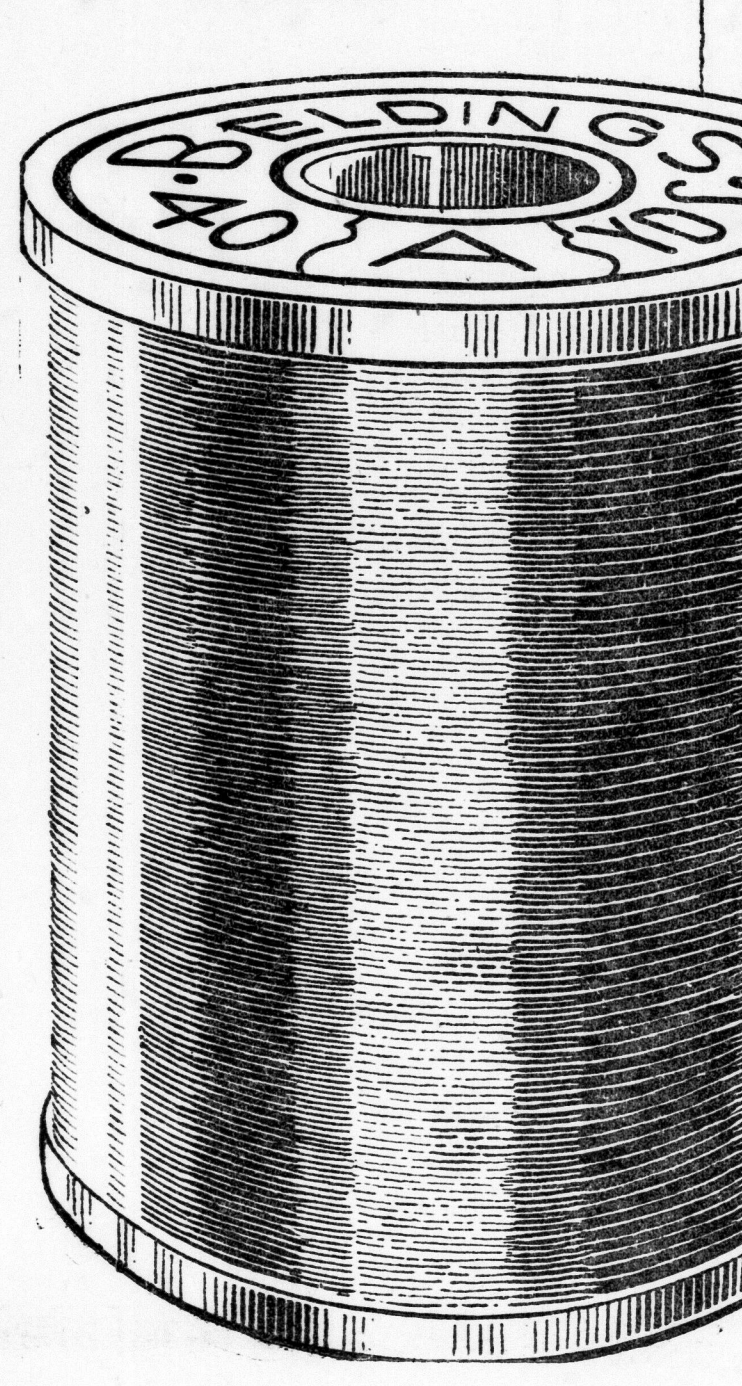

INTEREST KEENER IN MACHINE GUN WORK

Men of Corps Make Good Scores on Small Range.

With each turnout of the local companies of the 2nd Canadian Machine Gun Brigade the interest in the work becomes keener. Thursday night was no exception to the rule. Both the brigade itself and the local corps are filled with it are taking on a large number of recruits at every parade.

Last night the machine gunners were doing some rifle shooting on the miniature ranges at the armories. Many good scores were registered and the average obtained was high.
