Sir:-

The Department has not yet been advised either by yourself or by the Alberni Pacific Lbr. Co. if the licensed logging operations have been completed on the Kley-kley-house Reserve.

It is presumed that such is the case, as the last boom was reported on Jan. 3rd. 1935.

I must however request you to make immediate inquiry, bearing in mind the fact, that the company have applied their original deposit of \$1,987.00 toward the payment of royalties due on timber cut during July 1934.

You should secure from the Alberni Pacific Lbr. Co. a certified statement that they have cut all the merchantable timber on the Kley-kley-house Reserve, and a certificate from the District Forester that the reserve has been logged in a satisfactory manner and that no undue fire hazard has been created by the existence of logging debris.
