### Electrifying Railways.

(Montreal Herald)  
It is announced that the Ontario government is gathering information as to the possibility of electrifying the Temiscaming and Northern Ontario railway. This may be the first move in the direction of utilizing our immense water-power resources as a motive power for the railways. In alluding to the threatened coal famine in his address at the Toronto exhibition, Premier King intimated that such a policy might well be adopted by degrees, and a prominent business man of Montreal recently stated publicly that Canada cannot afford not to electrify her railways.

The advocates of a change in system point to the Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul railway, which is successfully operating nearly 700 miles of road by electricity. Officials state that the crushing radius of each electric locomotive is twice that of the steam locomotive and that the runs of the crews on passenger trains are now 224 miles instead of 110. A radical change of this nature, however, is bound to be touched gingerly and will probably be applied, as in England, first to suburban roads.

## NATIONWIDE FIGHT ON FAST DRIVING

**\$2 Fine For Each Mile Above Speed Limit in Louisville—Reports Show Accidents Increasing in Some United States Cities.**

Chicago, Sept. 22.—Despite the passage of numerous ordinances and the adoption of traffic regulations in the larger cities of the country in an effort to curb accidents from motor cars, reports from more than a dozen of the metropolitan cities of the middle west show an increase in the number of accidents for the first six months of 1922, compared with the same period of 1921.

This increase has caused city officials to prescribe drastic rules in governing motor traffic in an endeavor to lessen danger in modern traveling. Several of the cities are shown to be waging war on the speeder, in many cases impractical being added to fines by municipalities. Adoption of rules in turning at street intersections, elimination of glaring headlights and educational campaigns are other methods used in many cities in the campaign against accidents.

In Chicago, in 1921, deaths attributed to motor accidents totalled 575 as compared with 476 in 1920. Non-fatal accidents totalled 8,857 in 1921 and 7,985 in 1920. During the first four months of 1922 non-fatal accidents totalled 2,638.

An "unwritten law" is in effect in Louisville where police court judges assess a fine of \$2 for each mile an hour above the speed limit. Penitentiary sentence under charge of manslaughter is provided for drivers found responsible for deaths resulting from accidents. Cars must be under full control at all street intersections.

In Oklahoma City, most of the main traveled streets have been designated boulevards and before crossing these motorists are required to come to a complete stop. Heavy white "stop" signs painted on the pavement at these intersections remind the driver.


