

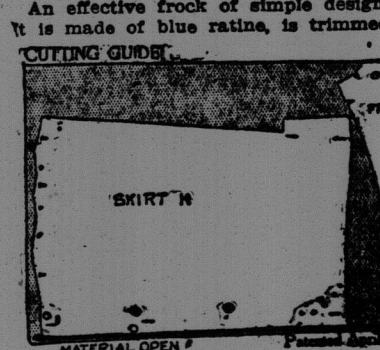

LA MARQUISE DE FONTENOY

Rasputin Might Have Changed the European Situation But For Attempt to Assassinate Him

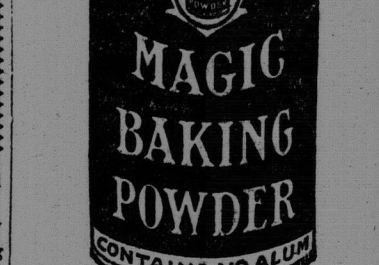
(Copyright, 1914, by the Brentwood Company) Had the Muscovite priest, Gregory Rasputin, been at St. Petersburg during the last fortnight, instead of being confined to his bed, many thousand miles away at Irkutsk, the capital of Siberia, recovering from the two grave stab wounds inflicted upon him by his would-be assassin, a woman named Guseva, it is possible the war situation might have never differed.

Why did the Czar listen to Rasputin? Count Witte, the eminently sensible statesman who so widely accepted abroad that the priest exercises any hypnotic influences over Nicholas and the Czarina, or that they are the prey to a mysticism of which he is the chief exponent, Witte regards him as a kindly, good humored Siberian peasant, altogether averse to the superstition which one is wont to associate with influential divines, and exceedingly fond of life, personifying the common sense, patience and cheerfulness of the typical Muscovite peasant.

On the last occasion of Witte's seeing Rasputin, the latter was brought to his home in St. Petersburg by a mutual friend, and spent two hours talking, according to the count, most interestingly. "The populace," said he, "is always clamoring for miracles. It always wants miracles. And yet it pays no attention whatsoever to the greatest miracle of all, which is taking place every day and every hour before their eyes, namely, the miracle of birth."

Two steamships of the Battle Line are tied up in a German port—Hamburg. These are the Pandolia, Capt. Purdy, and the Trebia, with a master.

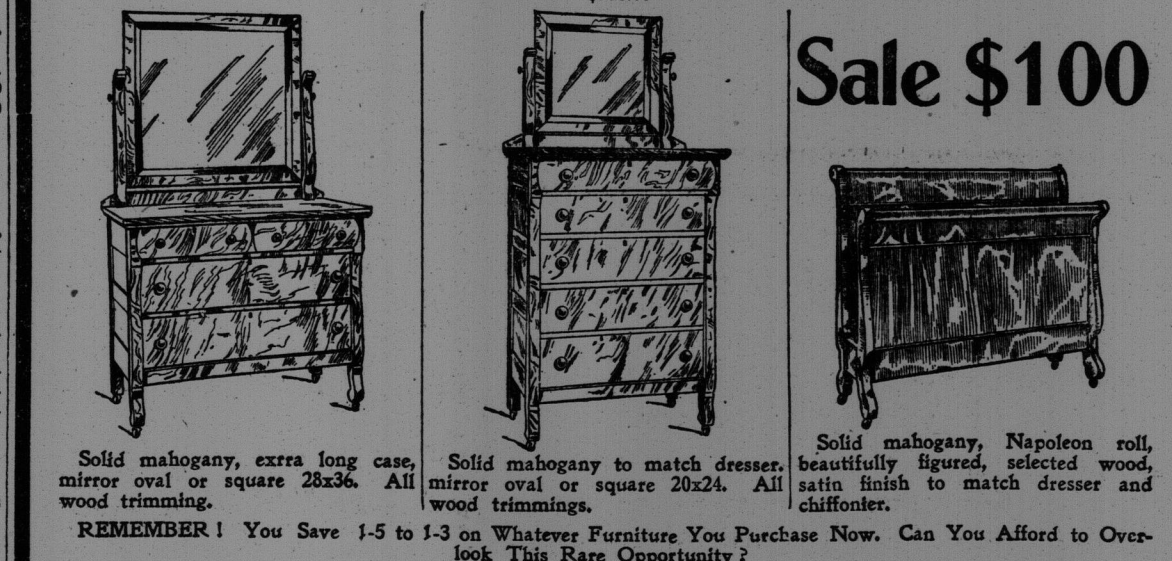

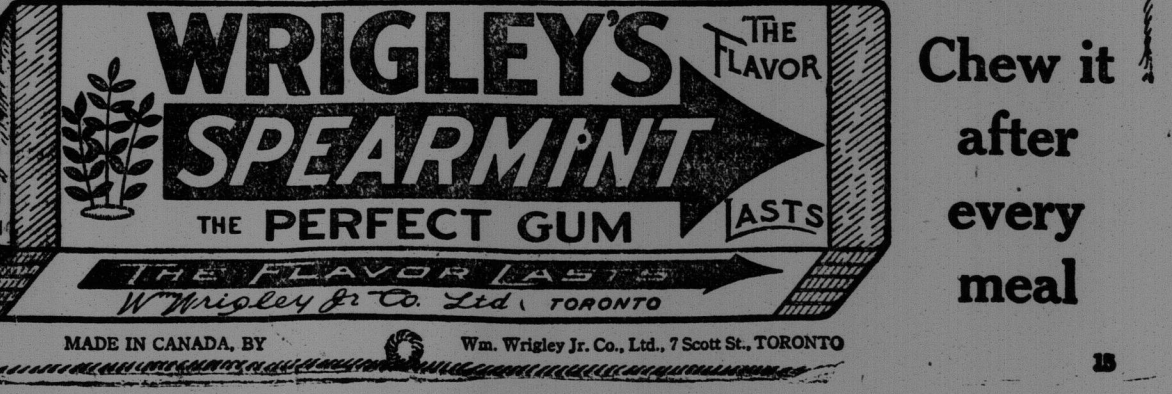
