AMENDMENTS OF REGULATIONS FOR SCHOOL EXAMINATIONS.

1. To the regulation respecting "Candidates who fail," add the words "unless in the interval they have become disqualified by age, this disqualification not to apply in cases of illness duly certified by medical authority."

2. In the optional subjects, instead of "at least one-half," "*one-third*" of the marks will in future be required."

3. In the Higher Examination of Women, candidates resident in Montreal, may take the lectures and examinations of the Ladies' Educational Association, as follows:—

(a) "Astronomy" instead of one of the Subjects in Experimental Physics.

(b) "English Literature" instead of "Chaucer."

(c) "Physical Geography" instead of "Geology and Palæontology."
