Some years ago, in a spasm of sympathetic tenderness toward the commission of capital crimes, the Legislature of the State abolished the death penalty, by the substitution of impriso ament for life. This has exhibited the same influence withalt similar relaxations of punishment for the highest of crimes, and homicides and horse stealings have shown a competitive enterprise in their commission. Pardons from tender-hearted executives have also abridged the terms of sentence and given an impulse to such bloodshed as we have now recorded.

So far there seems to have been no effort for tracing the perpetrators of this enormity. At the dead hour of night interruption in the fell purpose was not to be expected, but State and county authorities owe it to the community to discover the felons and bring them to a condign punishment.
